

EWUU Personal and Societal Resilience Package Course List

How does it work?

You can compile your own package the way you like it, mixing the courses from different institutions. Follow courses from at least **two** EWUU universities (that can include your own home institution!) from the list at your own pace throughout the year. To complete the package, there is a compulsory course **Societal and Personal Resilience Lab**. To make the most out of it, register for this course if you have completed, or are enrolled in, at least one other elective associated with the package. If you have completed an associated elective within the past six months, it may count toward the package as well!

>>For courses not offered by your home institution, you can register via EduXchange at www.eduxchange.nl/ewuu. Select your home institution and search for the course name.
